AUTHORITY: NRS 209.131, 28 C.F.R. Part 115

RESPONSIBILITY:

The Director is responsible for the establishment of all Departmental policies to ensure public, staff and inmate safety.

The Warden or designee is responsible to ensure that all inmates have access to evaluation, placement, and appropriate treatment while recognizing the inherent limitations of resources, and the need to maintain facility security, order and discipline, and the health and safety of all inmates.

The Medical Director and Mental Health Director have the responsibility to ensure both a medical and psychological evaluation for each inmate and that an appropriate plan has been established and is complied with by Medical and Mental Health staff.

494.01 PURPOSE AND POLICY

The purpose of this regulation is to provide guidance and references to the Nevada Department of Corrections' policies and procedures as they relate to any identification, assessment, review, and management of inmates who present or identify as transgender or intersex. All issues that could relate to transgender or intersex inmates are addressed in the Administrative Regulations and/or the Medical Directives that would pertain to the individual issue for all inmates.
