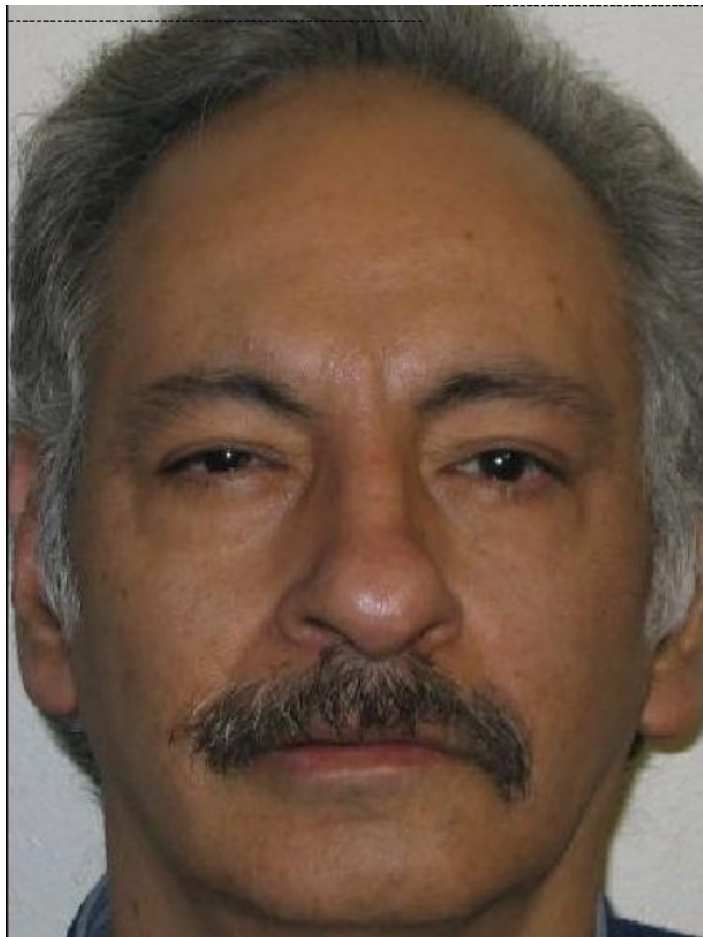

The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on May 3, 2021, Inmate Manuel Lopez, #21235, was pronounced dead High Desert State Prison in Las Vegas. Lopez, 62, was sentenced to death for first-degree murder. He came to the NDOC on July 25, 1985, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
