The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Tuesday, January 9, 2018, at approximately 4:19 AM, Inmate Nathan F. Kimmel, #12353, died at the Regional Medical Facility inside the Northern Nevada Correctional Center in Carson City, Nevada. Kimmel, a 76 year old male, was committed from Washoe County on May 18, 1977, and was serving a sentence of Life without the Possibility of Parole for First Degree Murder and Attempted Murder. The Carson City Sheriff's Office Coroner responded. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next of kin have been notified.
