The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Tuesday, April 28, 2020 at approximately 8:10 p.m., offender Ronald Sellers, #33048 died in the Hospice Unit at the Northern Nevada Correctional Center located in Carson City, Nevada. Sellers, a 52-year-old male, was a U.S. citizen and Washoe County commit serving Life without the possibility of Parole for Murder with consecutive sentences of Life without the Possibility of Parole for Use of a Deadly Weapon; 180 months for Robbery; 120 months for Burglary; and 72 months for Possession of a Firearm by a Prohibited Person. Seller arrived at the NDOC on August 10, 1992. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
