## Ten-year Plan Highlights

* The Legislature Approved Phase projection assumes that the female population will increase at a rate of $2.31 \%$ per year or a total of 208 inmates in a ten-year period versus $1.19 \%$ and 126 as predicted during the Governor Recommends Phase. The intricacies of the COVID-19 pandemic, however, have caused significant unexpected deviation from historical counts.
* Efforts to reduce incarceration and recidivism, including strategies such as increasing parole grant rates, expediting the ra te at which inmates are released, and prison reform laws passed by the 2019 Nevada Legislature aim at controlling the size of the female prison population and building capacity.
* The master plan begins with 1,397 beds for the female population and no emergency overflow beds. The forecast ends with 1,637 beds after the opening of a medium custody housing unit expansion at Florence McClure Correctional.

All project initiatives proposed in this model are hypothetical as they assume that the population projection will hold true.
