**Ten-year Plan Highlights**

- ❖ The Agency Request forecast estimates that the male in-house population will increase at rate of 2.20% annually beginning with Fiscal Year 2023 through June 2032, which amounts to 2046 males. The expected annual growth rate is higher than the anticipated 1.65% rate that was assumed during the Legislatively Approved Phase of 2021.
- ❖ Strategies aimed at increasing parole grant rates, expediting the rate at which inmates are released, and prison practices and reforms instituted starting in 2017 aim at controlling the size of the male prison population and reducing overcrowding have been effective; however, these efforts have been mystified by the COVID-19 pandemic and a rebound is expected as held up court cases are processed. This gradual rebound has exhibited a redistribution of custody levels towards larger percentages of more serious offenders, however, that require housing in fenced prison campuses and larger inmate to staff ratio ratios than those that qualify for minimum and medium custodies.
