The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Tuesday, January 5, 2021 at approximately 3:48 p.m., Offender Phillip Bradley, #36193 died at Saint Mary's Regional Medical Center in Reno, Nevada. Bradley was being housed at Lovelock Correctional Center in Lovelock, Nevada. Bradley, a 63-year-old male, was a U.S. citizen and Clark County commit serving 750 Months to Life With the possibility of Parole for three counts of Sexual Assault victim under 16 and 1 count of Lewdness with a Minor. Bradley arrived at the NDOC on March 2, 1992. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
