



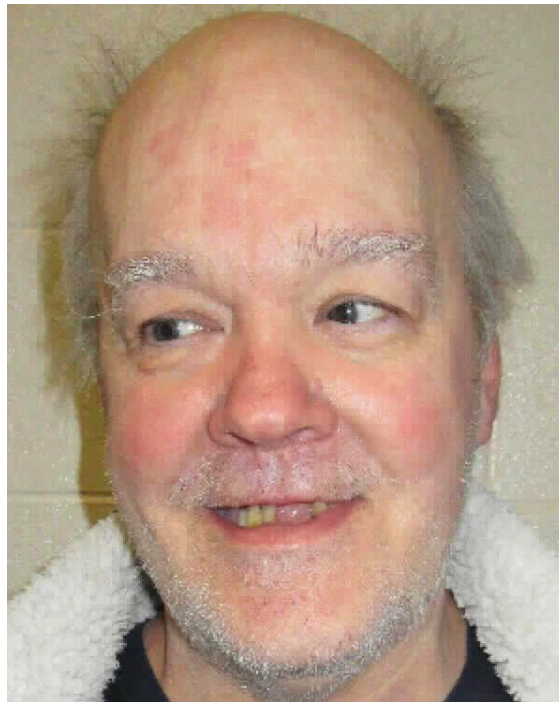

The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Sept. 1, 2022, offender Richard Haberstroh, #25189, was pronounced dead at Summerlin Hospital in Las Vegas. Haberstroh, 67, was serving a death sentence at Ely State Prison for first-degree murder with a use-of-a-deadly-weapon enhancement, kidnapping I, sexual assault and robbery. He came to the NDOC on Nov. 25, 1987, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin was notified.
