The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Jan. 7, 2022, Inmate Miguel Pascoe #1243091, was pronounced dead at Northern Nevada Correctional Center in Carson City, Nev. Pascoe, 78, was serving 4 to 10 years for attempted lewdness with a child under age 14 with a concurrent sentence of 4 to 10 years for attempted lewdness with a child under age 14. He came to the NDOC on March 19, 2021, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
