The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Dec. 11, 2021, Inmate Justin Meissner, #29914, was pronounced dead at Renown Medical Center in Reno. Meissner, 58, was serving a sentence of 10 years to life with the possibility for parole at Lovelock Correctional Center for lewdness with a child under the age of fourteen years. He came to the NDOC on Sept. 15, 2010, from Washoe County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
