The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on June 14, 2021, Inmate Ralph Miles, #86275, was pronounced dead at Carson Tahoe Regional Medical Center in Carson City. Miles, 54, was serving 30 years to life with parole at Northern Nevada Correctional Center for lewdness with a child under 14 and sexual assault against child under 16.

He came to the NDOC on June 1, 2005, from Washoe County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Attempts to contact next-of-kin were unsuccessful.
