The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Tuesday, November 24, 2020 at approximately 8:10 p.m., offender Sandoval, Jorge, #1212242 died at High Desert State Prison in Las Vegas, Nevada. Sandoval, a 47-year-old male, was a U.S. citizen and Clark County commit serving 72 – 180 months for Attempt Sexual Assault victim under 16. Sandoval arrived at the NDOC on February 20, 2019. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
