The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on April 29, 2021, Inmate Val Stallworth, #71238, was pronounced dead at the Regional Medical Center in Northern Nevada Correctional in Carson City. Stallworth, 67, was serving two life sentences for first-degree murder, kidnapping 1 with substantial bodily harm, robbery, use of a deadly weapon enhancement, kidnapping 1, robbery and burglary with a firearm/deadly weapon . He came to the NDOC on Dec. 11, 2001, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
