







**AUTHORITY:** NRS 209.131

**RESPONSIBILITY**

The Wardens are responsible to establish and maintain in their institutions a secure control center that serves as the communication and movement control hub for the entire institution.

**415.01 CONTROL CENTER PROCEDURES**


1. The control center will be staffed according to the specific institution's staffing pattern for the control center.
  - A. The staffing plan will be developed according to the layout and amount of equipment that needs to be monitored.
  - B. It will be staffed on a 24 hour a day, 7 days a week basis.
  - C. At no time will the control center be left vacant.
2. Detailed procedures for the Control Center operations are contained in a separate confidential manual.


**APPLICABILITY**
