RESPONSIBILITY

Medical Division staff has the responsibility to have knowledge of and comply with this regulation.


623.01 HEALTH CARE FOR WOMEN

1. Female inmates will be provided appropriate medical care to include screening, diagnostic, therapeutic, and supportive care for those medical problems unique to women. Specific health services available to female inmates include:

- A. Care for the pregnant inmate (Prenatal, intrapartum, and postpartum care).
- B. Birthing in an appropriate setting.
- C. Family planning counseling may be included prior to release from prison.
- D. Gynecology consultations and/or procedures indicated for the prevention or treatment of a serious medical condition.
- E. Health maintenance examinations proven to be beneficial in treating or preventing serious medical conditions.

APPLICABILITY


1. This regulation requires a Medical Directive for care of the female inmate.
