

The Nevada Department of Corrections has a Zero Tolerance policy for any form of sexual misconduct. Sexual misconduct includes sexual abuse, sexual assault, sexual harassment and/or consensual sex between any staff member, contractor, volunteer or inmate and inmates. Any staff member, contractor or volunteer who either engages in sexual misconduct, fails to report sexual misconduct, or knowingly condones sexual misconduct with or between inmates shall be subject to disciplinary action and may be subject to criminal prosecution.

The Department shall take a pro-active approach regarding the prevention, detection, response and punishment of any type of sexual misconduct.

Inmates can report any form of sexual misconduct, retaliation by other inmates or staff for reporting sexual misconduct, and staff neglect or violation of responsibilities related to PREA

## **Inmate Reporting**

- **▶** Verbal or written report to ANY staff member
- > Submit an inmate request form
- > Submit a grievance
- **▶** Have a family/friend report on your behalf
- > Phone call to numbers listed below
- > Written complaint to New Mexico of Corrections
- > Inmates may request to remain anonymous

Written complaint forms can be obtained through casework staff or the Law Library, but any written format will be accepted.
