The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Monday, June 19, 2017, at approximately 3:45 PM, Inmate Duke Fredrick Cranford, #13023, died at the Regional Medical Facility located inside the Northern Nevada Correctional Center in Carson City, Nevada. Cranford, a 63 year old male, was committed from Carson City on July 14, 1977 and was serving Double Life for First Degree Murder, Battery on a Police Officer, Battery by Prisoner and other charges. The Carson City Sheriff's Office Coroner responded and an autopsy is being scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next of kin have been notified.
