The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Saturday, March 5, 2016, at approximately 4:07 pm, Inmate James William Gibson, #1016867, was found unresponsive in his bed, in his cell, at Lovelock Correctional Center in Lovelock, Nevada. Medical staff was unable to revive him. Inmate Gibson, a 61 year old, male, was committed from Elko County on March 27, 2008. Gibson was serving 480 months to Life with Parole for Lewdness with a Minor. The Pershing County Sheriff's Office Coroner responded and an autopsy is being scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next of kin have been notified.
