The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Thursday, October 24, 2019 at approximately 4:14 AM, Inmate Larry Wisenbaker, #64320, died at Renown Regional Medical Center in Reno, Nevada. Wisenbaker, a 55-year-old male and U.S. citizen who was incarcerated at Lovelock Correctional Center, was a Clark County commit serving 240 months-to-Life with consecutive sentences for Sexual Assault and Lewdness with a minor under age 16. Wisenbaker arrived at the NDOC on February 18, 2000. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
