The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Sunday, June 7, 2020 at approximately 1:31 p.m., offender Rodney Gholston, #36428 died at Centennial Hills Hospital located in Las Vegas, Nevada. Gholston was being housed at Southern Desert Correctional Center. Gholston, a 53-year-old male, was a U.S. citizen and Clark County commit serving a Life sentence for 1st Degree Murder, Use of a Deadly Weapon Enhancement, and Possession of Controlled Substance. Gholston arrived at the NDOC on March 30, 1992. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. NDOC has been unable to locate any next-of-kin.
