The NDOC has been gradually converting its offender population racial and ethnic group categories pursuant to the the U.S. Office of Management and Budget 1997 Standards for the Classification of Federal Data on Race and Ethnicty. These standards encompass a minimum of five racial groups and and Hispanic or Latino as a dichotomus ethnic category.
