- g. The distribution of total incarcerated individuals by sentence length category and long-term sentence type is retrieved from Report OMDSLB generated by Nevada Offender Tracking Information System (NOTIS) and represents the longest sentence currently being served by the offender.

The NDOC has been gradually converting its offender population racial and ethnic group categories pursuant to the U.S. Office of Management and Budget 1997 Standards for the Classification of Federal Data on Race and Ethnicty. These standards encompass a minimum of five racial groups and and Hispanic or Latino as a dichotomus ethnic category.
