

NDOC Temporary Administrative Regulations Summaries

(All regulations to be reviewed at least once every three years)

AR 223 Inmate Organizational Fundraisers	Temporary Date: 11/16/17	Previous AR Date: 1/14/16
<p>Summary of changes: Revisions include administrative language and technical amendments, and scope of responsibility to ensure accountability. Regulation clarifies eligible entities for fundraising activity to be registered 501(c)(3) or school organizations. In addition, this amendments works to clarify the processes to ensure continuity across all institutions and to clarify the documentation process.</p>		
AR 430 Transportation of Inmates	Temporary Date: 9/26/17	Previous AR Date: 8/30/17
<p>Summary of changes: Revisions include administrative language and technical amendments, as well as adding a section specifically for transportation of inmates who have escaped or absconded from NDOC custody. Original transportation regulation draft, provided restrictions that were not operationally safe.</p>		
AR 452 Hostage Situations	Temporary Date: 09/08/17	Previous AR Date: 01/05/12
<p>Summary of changes: The Hostage Situation regulation included an update of administrative and technical amendments; clearly defined responsibilities; mandates requirements for all visitors and staff for safety and security; updates the critical items to be included in the "Confidential Manual"; ensures appropriated training for all staff on activities and duties during a hostage situation; and requires that all operation procedures for hostage situations are provided to the Director to have an "off site" copy to manage critical situation.</p>		
AR 573 Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Screening and Classification	Temporary Date: 10/05/17	Previous AR Date: 5/19/15
<p>Summary of changes: PREA was updated to ensure responsibility for activities was clearly defined; administrative language and technical amendments consistent with federal and state regulations and policies; inclusion of transgender/Intersex language as required by federal law; and institutional placement based on gender identity clarified. As an example, language was changed from "possible" aggressor to "potential" aggressor based.</p>		
AR 639 Medical Records	Temporary Date: 1/11/18	Previous AR Date: 9/16/14
<p>Summary of changes: To ensure clear responsibilities for compliance with federal and state regulations governing medical records; document the requirements for access, transport, updating, and transferring medical records; and ensure that all medical practitioners, to include contract employees, are responsible to comply with this regulation.</p>
