The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Nov. 7, 2021, Inmate Michael Magness, #1250229, was pronounced dead at Northern Nevada Correctional Center in Carson City, Nev. Magness, 46, was serving 12-30 months with a consecutive sentence of 12 to 30 months for lewdness with a child 14 or 15 years of age. He came to the NDOC on Nov. 5, 2021, from Washoe County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
