The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on May 15, 2021, Inmate Paul Hill, #15508, was pronounced dead at the Hospice Unit in Northern Nevada Correctional in Carson City. Hill, 62, was serving Life without the Possibility of Parole for a Habitual Criminal with a consecutive sentence of 8 years to Life with the Possibility of Parole for Possession of a Controlled Substance for Sale. He came to the NDOC on April 27, 1993, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
