The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on July 25, 2021, Inmate Brad Montgomery, #1038563, was pronounced dead at the High Desert State Prison Infirmary in Las Vegas. Montgomery, 66, was serving a sentence of 149 years to life with the possibility of parole for Sexual Assault (victim under 16), three counts of Use of a Minor in Producing Child Pornography and Lewdness with a Minor. He came to the NDOC on July 29, 2009, from Churchill County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
