The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Thursday, December 24, 2020 at approximately 3:39 a.m., Offender Raymundo Olvera, #1058228 died at Renown Medical Center in Reno, Nevada. Olvera was being housed at Lovelock Correctional Center in Lovelock, Nevada. Olvera, a 58-year-old male, was a U.S. citizen and Clark County commit serving a sentence 240 months to Life with the possibility of Parole for Sexual Assault against a child under 16. Olvera arrived at the NDOC on October 13, 2010. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
