The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that at approximately 4:20 AM this morning two court ordered defendants walked away from the Three Lakes Valley Boot Camp located adjacent to the Southern Desert Correctional Center on Cold Creek Road, just off US 95 in Northern Clark County, Nevada. It is alleged the court ordered defendants stole a correctional officer's vehicle, a 2013 brown Nissan Altima.

Both of the court ordered defendants were accounted for during the 4:00 AM count and noticed missing at 4:21 AM. Local law enforcement agencies were immediately notified and Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department arrived on scene to assist the NDOC's Office of the Inspector General with the investigation.

Court ordered defendant Shane Perez-Vallestro #1142605, is 18 years old, and was admitted to the program from Clark County on July 16, 2015 for an attempted invasion of home. Court ordered defendant Marvin Baldridge #1146612, is 23 years old, and was admitted to the program from Washoe County on September 18, 2015 for obtaining / using personal identifying information.


The Nevada boot camp, housing court ordered defendants authorized under NRS 176A.780, is a 190 day court ordered diversionary program of regimented discipline for first time felony convictions with no previous incarceration exceeding 364 days. Upon successful completion, the court has the option to place the boot camper on probation in lieu of being sent to prison.

The incident is under investigation and no further details are available at this time.
