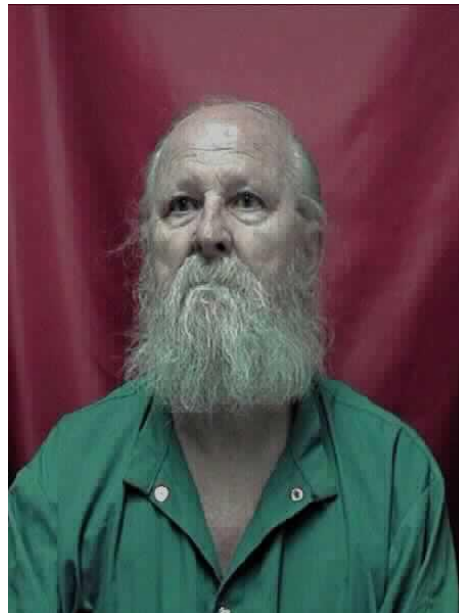

The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Tuesday, December 29, 2020 at approximately 10:47 p.m., Offender Paul Bouteiller, #66308 died at Renown Regional Medical Center in Reno, Nevada. Bouteiller was being housed at Lovelock Correctional Center in Lovelock, Nevada. Bouteiller, a 73-year-old male, was a U.S. citizen and Washoe County commit serving 240 months to Life for Sexual Assault with five consecutive 48-120 months for Lewdness with a Child under 14 Years of Age. Bouteiller arrived at the NDOC on August 26, 2000. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
