### **NDOC to close two conservation camps**

The Nevada Department of Corrections announced last week plans to close two minimum-custody institutions known as conservation camps.

Carlin Conservation Camp (CCC) in Carlin and Jean Conservation Camp (JCC) in Jean will cease operations by July 1, 2026.

"As a greater number of offenders qualify for house arrest and other transitional programs, the NDOC determined the cost of keeping these locations open was no longer beneficial," said Director James Dzurenda.

All offenders housed at the camps will be relocated into other correctional facilities prior to June 30, 2026. NDOC staff will continue to patrol the camps until all equipment, computers, furniture and supplies are completely removed.

All staff working at each location will be given a list of all NDOC positions and locations they can transfer to, as well as other available State of Nevada positions.

The Department of Corrections will return the CCC property to the City of Carlin and the closure of JCC will have no impact on the unincorporated town of Jean.
