

The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Feb. 27, 2022, Inmate Herman Cantrell, #81065, was pronounced dead at Northern Nevada Correctional Center in Carson City, Nev. Cantrell, 74, was serving 2 to 5 years for Stop required on Signal of Police Officer with a consecutive sentence of 5 years to life for First-Degree Kidnapping with Use of a Deadly Weapon with 2 concurrent sentences of 5 to 15 years for Robbery with the Use of a Deadly Weapon with a consecutive sentence of 6 to 15 years for Robbery with the Use of a Deadly Weapon with a consecutive sentence of 2 to 5 years for Stop required on Signal of Police Officer. He came to the NDOC on May 4, 2004, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. No next-ofkin was designated.
