The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on July 8, 2022, Inmate Juan Castillo-Romero, 1254711 was pronounced dead at High Desert State Prison in Las Vegas, Nev. Castillo-Romero, 32, was serving 28 to 84 months for battery with a deadly weapon with substantial bodily harm. He came to the NDOC on March 17, 2022, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin was notified.
