The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Nov. 3, 2022, Offender Ivan Miller, #18732, was pronounced dead at High Desert State Prison. Miller, 65, was serving life without parole for first-degree murder. He came to the NDOC on Aug. 31, 1983, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin was notified.
