The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Aug. 30, 2022, offender Casey Robinson, #1255312, was pronounced dead at High Desert State Prison in Las Vegas. Robinson, 37, was serving 16 months to 40 months for attempted battery causing substantial bodily harm. He came to the NDOC on April 1, 2022, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin was notified.
