The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Oct. 25, 2021, Inmate Carlton Spraggins, #1241243, was pronounced dead at High Desert State Prison in Las Vegas, Nev. Spraggins, 66, was serving 12-30 months for a DUI. He came to the NDOC on Jan. 1, 2021, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
