The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on April 11, 2022, Inmate John Warren, 1201909, was pronounced dead at Carson Tahoe Regional Medical Center. Warren, 55, was serving aggregated sentences of 72 months to 180 months at Northern Nevada Correctional Center for robbery, burglary and a use of a deadly weapon enhancement. He came to the NDOC on July 27, 2018, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Attempts to notify next-of-kin were unsuccessful.
