The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Jan. 10, 2022, Inmate Tarik Goicoechea, #79759, was pronounced dead High Desert State Prison in Las Vegas, Nev. Goicoechea, 36, was serving 12-72 months for assault with a deadly weapon and 60-198 months for racketeering. He came to the NDOC on Feb. 23, 1985, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
