The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Dec. 15, 2021, Inmate Marland Jackson, #1184944, was pronounced dead at High Desert State Prison in Las Vegas, NV. Jackson, 45, was serving a sentence of 180-540 months for second-degree murder with use-of-a-deadly-weapon enhancement. He came to the NDOC on Sept. 25, 2017, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
