The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on July 25, 2021, Inmate Liliana Pinto, #1239033, was pronounced dead at Florence McClure Women's Correctional Center in Las Vegas. Pinto, 35, was serving a sentence of five to 12 years for Voluntary Manslaughter with Use-of-Deadly-Weapon Enhancement. She came to the NDOC on Nov. 13, 2020, from Clark County. An autopsy was requested per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
