

The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Saturday, January 2, 2021 at approximately 5:45 p.m., Offender William Drewry, #1042328 died at Saint Mary's Regional Medical Center in Reno, Nevada. Drewry was being housed at Lovelock Correctional Center in Lovelock, Nevada. Drewry a 62-year-old male, was a U.S. citizen and Clark County commit serving 60 Months to 360 months for Attempted Sexual Assault Victim Under 16 and Attempted Lewdness With a Minor. Drewry arrived at the NDOC on October 15, 2009. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
