The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Saturday, March 3, 2018, at approximately 4:20 PM, Inmate Harold Hipps, #87815, died in the Infirmary at High Desert State Prison which is located approximately thirty miles outside of Las Vegas, Nevada. Hipps, a 51 year old male, was committed from Clark County on July 6, 2016 and was serving 16-48 months on Arson II charges. Hipps had been released on parole November 17, 2017, but returned to prison January 17, 2018, after violating conditions of his parole. The Clark County Coroner's Office responded. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next of kin have been notified.
