The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Sunday, December 20, 2020 at approximately 8:06 a.m., Offender John Ledbetter, #80659 died at Lovelock Correctional Center in Lovelock, Nevada. Ledbetter, a 72-year-old male, was a U.S. citizen and Clark County commit serving 20 years to Life the Possibility of Parole for Sexual Assault with a Victim under 16. Ledbetter arrived at the NDOC on March 30, 2004. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
