The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Monday, November 25, 2019 at approximately 6:45 AM, Inmate Kamario Smith, #93336, died at St. Rose Dominican Hospital – San Martin campus in Las Vegas, Nevada. Smith, a 38-year-old male and U.S. citizen was being housed at High Desert State Prison. He was a Clark County commit serving 86 months-to-36 years for Sales of a Controlled Substance, Possession of a Controlled Substance for Sale, Use of a Deadly Weapon Enhancement, Conspiracy to Commit a Violent Crime, Robbery, and Ex-Felon / Prohibited Person in Possession of a Firearm. Smith arrived at the NDOC on April 19, 2012. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin has been notified.
