The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that at approximately 1:00 PM today, a minimum security inmate walked away from an outside work crew located in downtown Carson City.

The inmate, Michael David Lillie #1063604, a 37 year old white male, arrived at Stewart Conservation Camp on April 8, 2016. Serving 26 – 120 months for Driving under the Influence, Lillie had been out on parole but had violated and was rearrested in December 2015. Lillie is 6 feet tall, weighs 190 pounds with red hair and hazel eyes. He was last seen wearing blue jeans, a long sleeved blue shirt and black work boots.
