The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Monday, January 30, 2017, at approximately 4:15 PM, Inmate Mark John Petkovich, #62358, was found unresponsive in his bed at the Casa Grande Transitional Housing facility in Las Vegas, Nevada. The Las Vegas Fire Department responded and pronounced him deceased 4:30 PM. Petkovich, a 53 year old male, was committed from Clark County on May 14, 2014, and was serving 30 to 96 months for Burglary and Grand Larceny. The Clark County Coroner responded and an autopsy is being scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next of kin have been notified.
