

The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Saturday, January 9, 2021 offender Philip Zanghi, #1121740 died in the Infirmary of the Regional Medical Facility at Northern Nevada Correctional Center in Carson City, NV. He was a 74-year-old male, U.S. citizen and Clark County commit serving concurrent sentences of Life with the Possibility of Parole after 10 years for Lewdness with a Child under the age of 14, Life with the Possibility of Parole after 35 years for Sexual Assault with a Minor under the age of 14, and Life with the Possibility of Parole after 35 years for Sexual Assault with a Minor under the age of 14. Zanghi arrived at the NDOC on June 11, 2014. An autopsy was scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next-of-kin was notified.
