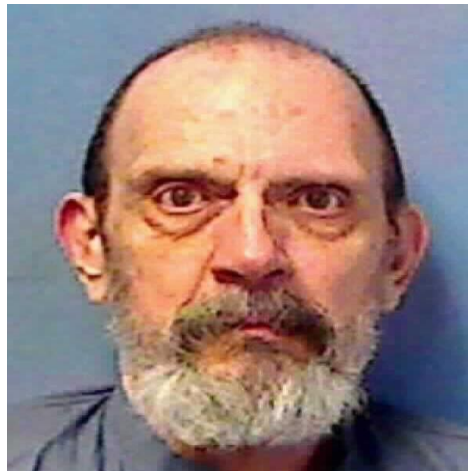

The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Sunday, October 20, 2019 at approximately 12:53 PM, Inmate Roland Hamilton, #46496, died at Centennial Hills Hospital in Las Vegas, Nevada. Hamilton, a 65-year-old male and U.S. citizen, was being treated for low blood pressure and fever at the hospital. He was incarcerated at High Desert State Prison, and was a Clark County commit serving consecutive Life without Parole sentences for kidnapping, battery, and sexual assault, with a consecutive 12-30 months sentence for extortion. Hamilton arrived at the NDOC on June 5, 1995. An autopsy will be scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Hamilton had no next-of-kin listed.
