The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) reports that on Monday, March 27, 2017, at approximately 1:02 PM, Inmate John Layton Stokes, # 34314, died at High Desert State Prison near Las Vegas, Nevada. Stokes, a 56 year old male, was committed from Elko County in 1991 serving 156 months to Life with the possibility of Parole for Sexual Assault Resulting in Substantial Bodily Harm. Stokes was released to parole in 2013. He violated and was returned to NDOC custody February 24, 2017. The Clark County Coroner responded and an autopsy is being scheduled per NRS 209.3815. Next of kin have been notified.
