**Model Purpose**

To incorporate the following:

- 1) Updated to reflect JFA April 2010 projection.
- 2) This plan closes NSP and WCC and reschedules the opening of Eagle's Nest from February 2012 to October 2012. Units 7 & 8 at HDSP are re-opened and also a long term care modular for medium and close custody inmates is open.

**Model Conditions & Assumptions**

- 1)The in-house male prison population is expected to grow at an average rate of .359% per fiscal year between July 2011 and June 2021.
- 2)The projected average outcount for the male population is 2.20% and this proportion is applied throughout the CIP.
