

In-house Population by Gender












Percentages by Substance Used

Note: The figures in this report involve estimates from live data extracted from a data warehouse. Thus, select distributions may not add up to 100% due to rounding or may not equal to the totals in published reports. Report run dates for select statistical information may affect totals and cause them not to balance to the actual population at month end until fully reconciled.

Unless otherwise stated, all data is derived from the NOTIS data warehouse, and only includes offenders which are in-house and in NDOC custody.

[12]: The recidivism rate at NDOC represents the proportion of offenders that are re-incarcerated within three years of release. This excludes offenders who were released from non-correctional facilities, were released from other jurisdictions, or were held by NDOC for other jurisdictions. This figure is not adjusted for deaths after release.

[13]: Residential Confinement data is derived from a report maintained by the NDOC Offender Management Division Case Work Specialists.
